

Fire Apparatus Driver/Operator 1A

Where: Beckwourth Fire Department will be hosting a Fire Apparatus Driver/Operator 1A class at Beckwourth Grizzly Station, located at 4076 Grizzly Ranch Rd, in Portola, California. The class will be taught by Kenny Osburn.

Description: This course provides information on fire apparatus preventive maintenance and driving/operating. Topics include routine tests, inspections, and servicing functions; operate, back, maneuver, and turn a fire apparatus in a variety of conditions; and operate all fixed systems and equipment on a fire apparatus. This course is based on the 2014 edition of NFPA 1002 Standard for Fire Apparatus Driver/Operator Professional Qualifications. This course fulfills the requirements for a Class A, B or C Firefighter Endorsement. All participants must hold at minimum a valid Class C Driver's license in California or Nevada

This course will be COVID compliant to the most current standards.

When: This is a 40-hour class and will be held on two weekends, June 12, 13, 19 & 20, 2021 from 0800 to 1800 hours each day.

The cost of the class is \$425.00 **excluding** the book. The book **required** for this class is the IFSTA Pumping Apparatus Driver/Operator Handbook 3rd edition. Upon completion of the class your certificate can be printed through the OSFM Acadis Training Portal. It is encouraged all students know their California State Training Identification number which can be found at <https://apps.cce.csus.edu/sites/stateFire/>. A State Training Identification number is not required to register for this course.

Register: The class will be hosted through First Alarm Services, LLC and limited to 15 students. Students will be required to register and submit payment with Elite Command Training at elite@elitecommandtraining.com.
