TRAINING PROGRAM COURSE DIRECTOR QUALIFICATIONS

The Course Director shall be a Physician, Registered Nurse, Physician Assistant or Paramedic currently licensed in the State of California, or an individual who holds a baccalaureate degree or equivalent in a related health field or equivalent. The course director shall have a minimum of one (1) year experience in an administrative or management level position and have a minimum two (2) years academic or clinical experience in prehospital care education within the last five (5) years.

The approved course director shall be qualified by education and experience in methods, materials, and evaluation of instruction which shall be documented by at least forty (40) hours in teaching methodology. The courses included, but are not limited to the following examples:

- California State Fire Marshal Instructor 1A and 1B
- National Fire Academy's Instructional Methodology
- Training programs that meet the United States Department of Transportation/National Highway Traffic Safety Administration 2002 Guidelines for Education EMS Instructors such as the National Association of EMS Educators Course
