- Be qualified by education and experience in methods, materials, and evaluation of instruction which shall be documented by at least forty (40) hours in teaching methodology. The courses included, but are not limited to the following examples:

 - ❖ National Fire Academy’s Instructional Methodology
 - ❖ Training programs that meet the United States Department of Transportation/National Highway Traffic Safety Administration 2002 Guidelines for Education EMS Instructors such as the National Association of EMS Educators Course
