Assess and treat as ABC's as appropriate
 Address any life threatening bleeding
 History and Physical
 Vital signs including Blood glucose (If appropriate)
 Oxygen: Titrate to SpO2 to 94%
 SMR as appropriate
 Check blood sugar

AEMT

AEMT
 Establish IV & Obtain Blood Draws
 Normal Saline bolus as appropriate to a max 250ml w/o BHPO
 Advanced Airway Management (Igel)
 Treat with appropriate Protocol / Medication within scope or BHPO

AEMT ALS medications allowed:
 Oral Acetaminophen, Asa, Albuterol, Benadryl, Activated Charcoal,
 Epinephrine IM, Dextrose, Ibuprofen, Isotonic Solutions,
 Glucagon IM, Naloxone, Nitroglycerine SL

AEMT OS

AEMT OS
 ECG, Defibrillate, Cardioversion

Additional Medications Allowed:
 Atropine, Epinephrine IV for Cardiac Arrest, Epinephrine IM for Acute
 Asthma Exacerbation, Furosemide, Lidocaine, Midazolam, Morphine,
 Sodium Bicarbonate

Use Pediatric Length Based Resuscitation Tape
 Treat with appropriate
 Protocol/Medication or BHPO

Consider early base contact if
 any questions regarding
 treatment or destination
 decision develop.

**Caution with fluid bolus. Monitor
 for any signs of Fluid overload /
 Pulmonary edema**
