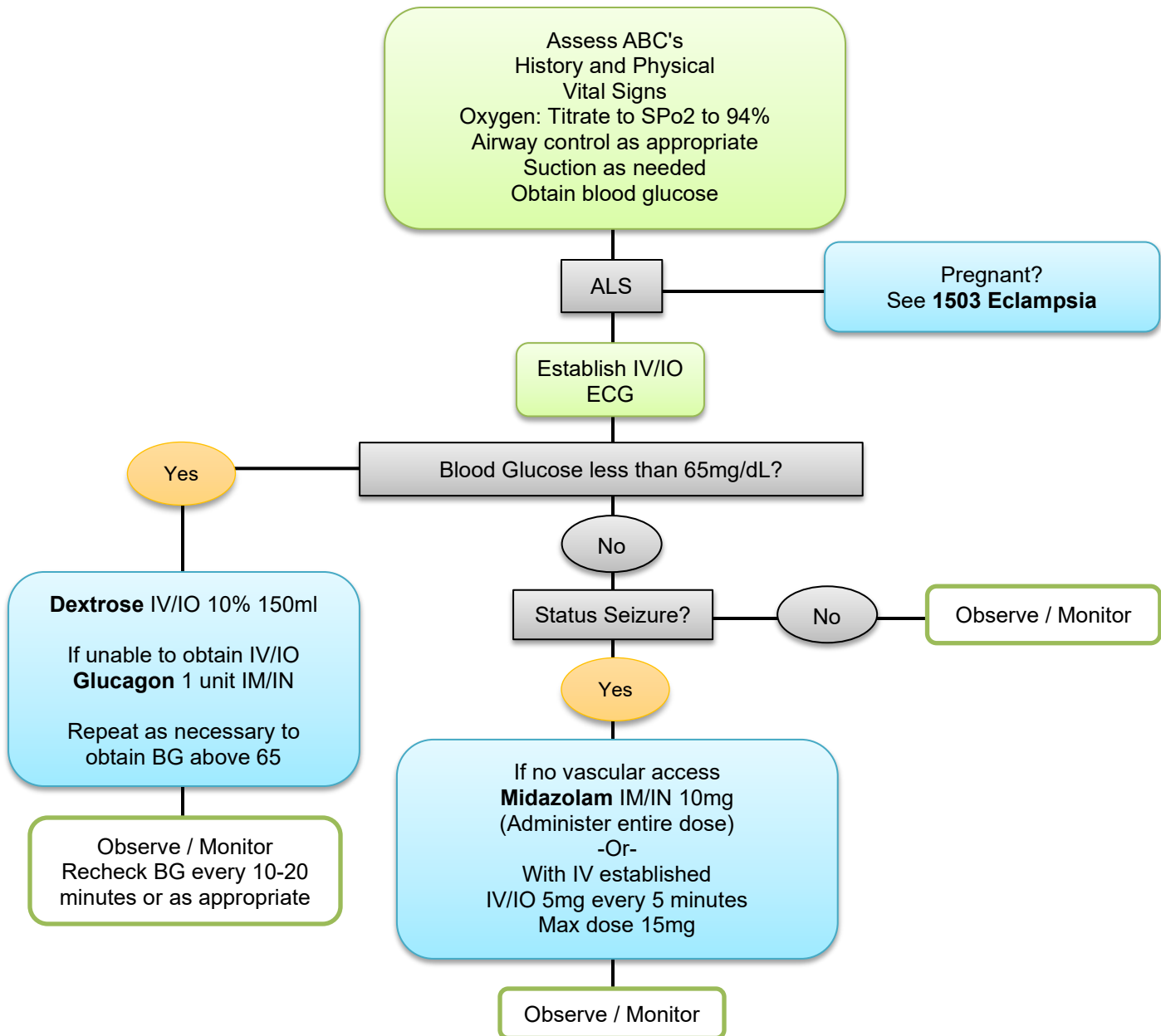

If Midazolam unavailable:

Diazepam may be used = IV/IO: Administer 2.5 - 10 mg titrated slowly to effect. If recurrent or persistent seizure may repeat once to a MAXIMUM of 20 mg with **Base Hospital Physician Order**.

IM: Administer 10 mg given (SLOWLY) deep IM may repeat once to a MAXIMUM of 20 mg with **Base Hospital Physician Order**.

Consider:

Status epilepticus: 2 or more consecutive seizures without a lucid interval or a single seizure lasting greater than 5 minutes.

Assess reason for seizure- History, Alcoholism, Trauma, Narcotic Dependence, Syncopal, and/or Diabetes.

Protect patient by removing objects or padding as possible, don't restrain.

Do NOT administer ORAL GLUCOSE unless patient can swallow
